



Hebron Presbyterian Church finds Crisp, Clear Sound Systems that are Easy to Operate

Located in Langley, British Columbia, the Hebron Presbyterian Church had the opportunity to fashion a customized facility the congregation could truly enjoy. When faced with the tough decision of the best audio equipment for the venue, the Pastor, Mr. Song, and Commercial Electronics Ltd. came to the unanimous decision to use TOA's reliable speakers, amplifiers, and Digital Signal Processor.

Hebron Presbyterian Church has been built out of a vacated school. The two buildings on the property were renovated into a facility suitable for the Hebron Presbyterian Church's needs. Three rooms would require an audio system with great sound clarity, reliability and which is easy to operate. The original school gymnasium, which was located in a separate building, was converted into the main sanctuary, while the second floor of the main administration building was converted into the second sanctuary and youth ministry. Many of the renovations were completed by teams of volunteers and contractors/sub-contractors, as the budget for the facility was a concern. The audio portion of the project was divided up into two phases, both being awarded to Commercial Electronics Ltd., and both using TOA products. Phase I saw the main sanctuary outfitted with TOA's HX-5W Variable Dispersion Speakers, complemented with Low Frequency Drivers (FB-120W) and powered by the IP Series Dual Channel Power Amplifiers.

Due to the overwhelming response and satisfaction of the congregation on the performance in the main sanctuary, when phase II of the project was initiated, Pastor Song contacted Mr. Steve Ho, Professional Audio Sales, at Commercial Electronics Ltd. Working as a team, Mr. Steve Ho, Mr. Gordon Bruce, Regional Sales Manager for TOA Canada Corporation, and Pastor Song, deployed a similar design and solution for the youth ministry, main sanctuary and second sanctuary.

The original equipment would be moved from the main sanctuary to the youth ministry, where new speakers would be added. The main sanctuary and second sanctuary would be upgraded with TOA's HX-5 Variable Dispersion Speakers and Low Frequency Drivers (FB-120W) powered by the DA-250F Multi-Channel Digital Power Amplifiers and the D-901 Digital Signal Processor. TOA's HX-5W Speakers fit the application well, and are known for their crisp, clear sound and high power handling. These systems provide articulate speech reinforcement coupled with live music amplification.
