

Portable, Confidential Conferencing at the Town of Whitby

Whitby Town Council Chamber meetings require a formal meeting room with a conference system that packs an intelligible audio punch. Whitby town meetings are presented with all participants on one level,



with the chairperson and speakers facing the audience. Whitby's Council Chambers meeting room layout requirements are constantly changing, moving the conference system from one area of the meeting room to another. Their conference system had to be portable, confidential, and intelligible while fitting the ever changing demands of the room.

Upgrading the technology in the Town of Whitby's 35 year old Council Chambers, required the new system to be automated, with portable conferencing, complete with intelligible sound, projectors, USB based presentations, and Rogers TV Broadcasting Equipment. The new equipment had to be easily integrated together for

seamless operation. The town appointed Duocom Canada to recommend, provide and install a reliable conference system for a meeting room with inter-changeable layout requirements.

Each unit features an infrared microphone and a monitor speaker, user control of the microphone and voting capabilities.

The Council Chambers have two possible meeting arrangements. The first arrangement is set up for Town Council meetings. This formal meeting is set up in a circular shape with the conference tables on tiered levels. The second meeting arrangement is set up for public meetings (including noise exemption requests, city planning, etc.). During the public meetings, Council Chambers are arranged so that all committee members and participants are on one level, with the committee facing the audience. TOA's TS-900 Series cordless Conference System allows for this portability and is ideal for any conference room that is apt to change the layout of the room, or the number of participants. TOA's TS-900 Series has the capability of being monitored by Creston control panels, which the Town of Whitby has been using. Creston's control panel allows the chairperson to be able to fully control all conferencing functions, including microphone functions such as mute on/off. The Town of Whitby can also expand the system to include voting (which is currently not being used). The conference system integrates nicely with the other products selected to work within the council chambers.
